


## Lindab Access door LKCR

Mounting instruction




## Access door

## I KCR



- 1 Access door
- 2 Over-centre catches
- 3 Handle
- 4 Fixing frame

- Release the door from the frame by opening the over-centre catches.
  Note! Be careful not to damage the locking spring.
- 2. Use the fixing frame as a template and cut out a hole in the duct. On an insulated duct, cut the hole on top of the duct. (Fig. 1).
- Apply a string of sealant around the hole and put the frame back. (Fig. 2).
- 4. Drill and fasten the frame with blind rivets. Do not use screws.
- 5. if the duct is insulated, the insulation cut section + 30 mm around the internal hole must be cladded with steel.
- 6. Mount the door in the frame and lock it. (Fig. 3).






